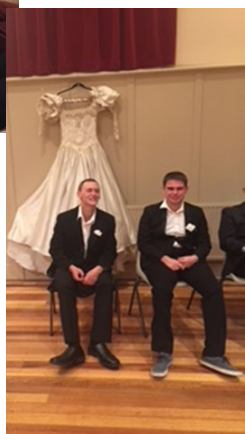


Seniors Forum and Morning Tea

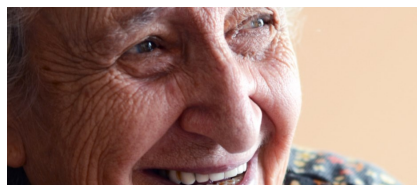


WORLD ELDER ABUSE AWARENESS DAY 2018 COMMUNITY FORUM
